Returning Student Verification Forms

Please complete the <u>Returning Student Verification</u> for your student(s) in your Parent Portal account: https://ddsbps.ddsbschools.ca/public/home.html

Attached you will find a reference sheet which contains instructions on (a) creating a Parent Portal account (if you have not yet done so), (b) adding new students to your existing account (all of your students will be linked to one account) and (c) updating the information that the school requires each new school year. It is very important to check and update your personal information and student waivers as they change yearly. This is also where you give permission for your grade 7 or 8 students to receive a Board issued Chromebook. Your Parent Portal account will follow your student/s throughout their education while in the DDSB, and you will also find access to Grades and Attendance, School Information, School Messenger (our Safe Arrival application), and other useful information.

If you have not yet created a Parent Portal account you will need the Access ID, which is your student's OEN number (found on any previous report card) and their Access Password (5 capital letters), which DDSB sent via email to you in early August.
